- Not be in bankrupt status;
- Be a member of PSO in good standing for a period of at least 30 days;
- Be willing to undergo a Vulnerable Police Sector Check.

#### **About the Board Position:**

The basic responsibilities of directors include:

- carrying out the organization's mission and goals
- planning and setting priorities
- supporting the senior staff person (Executive Director)
- financial monitoring
- ensuring adequate resources and managing them for the organization

The board meets monthly, sometimes twice a month, with directors serving on committees and working on initiatives as required.

We provide a training session for newly elected board members.
